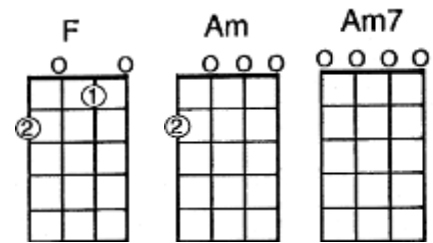


Eleanor Rigby
