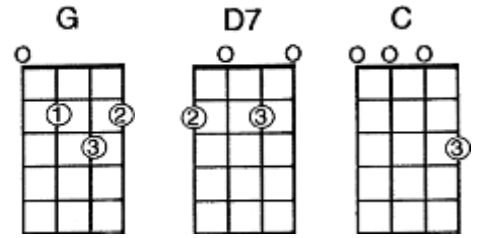


SUPERCALIFRAGILISTICEXPIALIDOCIOUS
