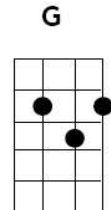
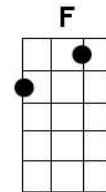
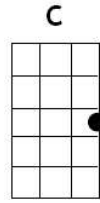


MY ISLAND HOME

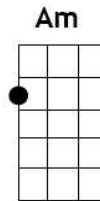
